JANUARY 2010 MINUTES

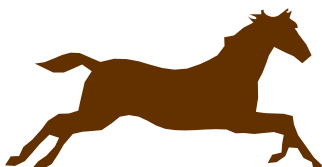

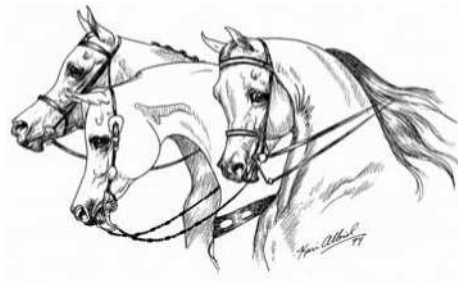
