On February 18, 2009, The History Channel's show Modern Marvels filmed a special on horse transport via Aircraft. The filming began at Winding Oaks farm in Ocala Fl, then on to Ocala International Airport and next to Ontario, California. The air date is set for late March - early April. The Ocala International Airport receives 5-6 horse transports each month using a Boeing 727-200. This aircraft can carry up to 21 horses and operates throughout the United States. This show should offer a unique insight to the details of horse air transport.

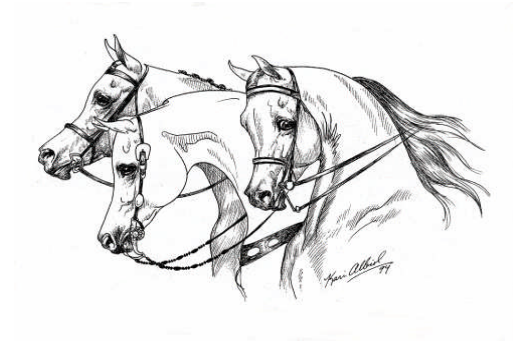

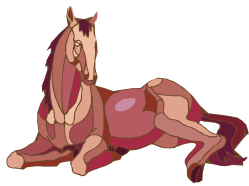
