From I 75, head west on Hwy 27 . PASS Plumley Farms, the Sanctuary Horse Rehab Center and SR 225 all on right side. Continue on Hwy. 27 approximately 1 more mile to the " little" town of Fellowship. There will be a BP Gas Station on the right. Get in the left turn lane and turn Left on Hwy.464 B. The road will quickly split in a " Y " , bear right. Go approximately 2 miles to the bottom of the first hill and take the first left. This is 115 Ave. ( but the sign is no longer there ) . There is a sign however for a " Siloam Baptist Church " Go approximately 2 miles and the road will make a hard 90 degree turn to the right, the road now becomes NW 35 Street. Go 2 more miles and there is a sign on the left for Hennessey Arabians. The sign is a shared sign with Leprechaun Farms and Rulet Jumps. There is a gate entrance and the gate will be open. Continue and follow the signs for Hennessey Arabians. The final sign and gate entrance into the farm is on the right. Gate will be open. Follow the road to the right passing the main house and head toward the barn parking area.

PS: will have **balloons** at intersections you turn at as some of the signs are down.
